



MONDAY, OCTOBER 8th

Read the song Moses sang to the Lord after Israel crossed the Red Sea. (Exodus 15:1-18)

What impresses you the most about God after reading this Scripture?

Which words bring the most comfort to you today?

Read verse 13 over again, but write your name in the blanks...

"In your unfailing love you will lead _____. In your strength you will guide _____ to your holy dwelling."

What decisions or difficulties do you face today that require God's guidance?

Talk to Him about these decisions and ask for His leadership.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9th

Read Hannah's prayer after dedicating her son Samuel to the Lord. (1 Samuel 2:1-11)

What impresses you the most about God in this passage?

In verse 2, Hannah proclaims "there is nor Rock like our God."
Can you think of three characteristics of rocks that are also true of God?

Recall a time in your life when God was like a solid rock to you.

What sources of stability (besides God) are you currently trusting?

Why is it often easier to trust in these things rather than in the Lord?

Bring your needs before the Lord, confessing in each area that He is your Rock.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 10th

Enter the Apostle John's vision by reading Revelation 15:1-4.

What impresses you the most about God in these verses?

The angels sing about God' holiness in verse 4. According to their song...
Besides God, what other sources of holiness are there?

How does God demonstrate His holiness?

What is your responsibility in light of God's holiness?

What "righteous acts" have you seen the Lord reveal in your life?

As you pray, confess that God alone is holy and consider how you might fear Him and glorify His name with your life.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 11th

Read the description of Jesus found in Hebrews 7:25-27.

Jesus is compared to human priests in this passage. In what ways is Jesus better than human priests?

What words are used to describe Jesus that prove He is God?

How would you compare your own record with the record of Jesus in these areas...
Holiness?

Blamelessness?

Purity?

According to verse 25, what percentage of you is Jesus able to save?

Spend some time in prayer. Acknowledge the holiness of Jesus. Confess your unholiness. Thank Him for your salvation. Bring any unconfessed sin to Him, He is your perfect High Priest.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 12th

Read Isaiah 57:15

What impresses you most about God in this verse?

What two locations are described as God's home in this verse?

The Message version translates a portion of this verse, *"I live in the high and holy places, but also with the low-spirited, the spirit-crushed. And what I do is put new spirit in them, get them up on their feet again."* In what ways do you feel crushed, disappointed, or humiliated today?

Bring your brokenness to the Holy One in prayer, asking Him to heal you and put a new spirit in you.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13th

Review your thoughts from the devotions of the past week.

Write down:

A reason to praise God.

A sin to confess.

An observation to share at your Cottage Meeting.

A goal for the coming week.

Pray for spiritual awakening – for yourself and for our church body.
